

I am directed to forward herewith the application  
of Chirac Public School, Begumpet, Hyderabad, to the  
Secretary, CBSE, New De'hi, and to state that this Govt.,  
have no objection to accord affiliation to it, subject to  
the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

1. The State Govt., reserves the right to withdraw the  
above certificate at any time if the Management fails to  
comply with the instructions of the State Government such  
as illegal removal of the teachers, non-payment of salaries  
to the teaching and non-teaching staff as per the approved  
scales etc.
2. Admissions should be made with the bonafied date of birth  
certificate.
3. All the untrained teachers should be replaced by the  
trained teachers.
4. The Management should collect the tuition fee and special  
fee etc., as prescribed by Government from time to time.
5. The strength in Classes should be as per Rules in force.
6. The Management should follow the State syllabus for  
Classes from I to V.--
7. The School should follow the three Language formula.

8. The DEO or his nominee should be invited when the Management makes recruitment of candidates for various categories of posts.
9. Staff salaries should be paid as per Government Scales of pay.
10. Play facilities should be provided.
11. The management should not collect donations either from the students or parents for admission.
12. The management should implement the teachers provident fund scheme.
13. No pupil studying in the school now is put to hardship for continuing in the same school.
14. No classes should be opened without prior sanction/permission from the competent authority.
